Romans 7:21– Romans 8:1-4

So I find it to be a law that when I want to do right, evil lies close at hand. ²² For I delight in the law of God, in my inner being, ²³ but I see in my members another law waging war against the law of my mind and making me captive to the law of sin that dwells in my members. ²⁴ Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? ²⁵ Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin. ¹ There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. ² For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. ³ For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, ⁴ in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

If Fenton Schools are closed due to poor weather conditions, Tyrone Wednesday night is cancelled as well.



Responsive Reading: Isaiah 53

¹ Who has believed what he has heard from us? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

² For he grew up before him like a young plant, and like a root out of dry ground; he had no form or majesty that we should look at him, and no beauty that we should desire him.

³ He was despised and rejected by men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

⁴ Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

⁵ But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.

⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

⁷ He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth.

⁸ By oppression and judgment he was taken away; and as for his generation, who considered that he was cut off out of the land of the living, stricken for the transgression of my people?

⁹ And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth.

¹⁰ Yet it was the will of the LORD to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

¹¹ Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities.

¹² Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.

Great Lakes Presbytery Prayer Points

Redeemer Presbyterian Church, Traverse City, Michigan - Pray for healing and comfort for those in our congregation dealing with health issues, our home bound members and for the Single MOMM organization and an upcoming event we are hosting for them. **Praise for** our dedicated Sunday School teachers and our Women's Ministry Leaders.

Rev. Satoshi Kawachi - Pray for the healing process of Quebec and its Muslim community after the horrendous hate crime at a mosque on 1/29/17; preparation for our return to Quebec after Cally's follow up angiogram exam at Johns Hopkins Hospital, which is postponed due to a case of the shingles; Cally's mother, who is not doing great--in fact, she was taken to the ER after nearly fainting from an erratic heart-rate and BP of 185/150 and was hospitalized for 2 nights in mid-Feb.; Cally's ESL teacher certification program at GMU; and Suzi & Sophi's continued studies at JMU and the financial provisions (scholarships) for 2017-2018. **Praise for** the new supporting churches and individuals added during this HMA, as well as, Satoshi's successful eye surgery for Pterygium on Jan. 31, and his slow but steady healing.
