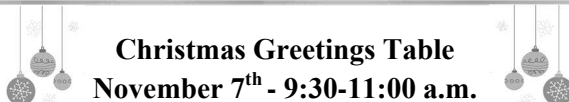


Kids Hope Meeting Next Sunday, October 25.

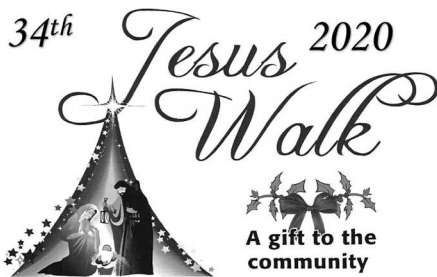

Chairpersons still needed:

Clean Up: This Chairman will need to schedule teams of people to begin at eight o'clock each evening to cleanup. This should include garbage pick up and disposal outside and a separate group to clean up indoors in kitchen and east hall restrooms (actor and volunteer use).

Need to confirm all people ahead of time, provide scripts that are preprinted and should not be altered in any way.
