Two new Adult Sunday school topics will begin next Sunday, 1/5

Pastor Mark's 9:00 AM Sunday School class meets behind the kitchen. Our new topic will be on the most important Biblical and theological topic: **The Cross and Resurrection of Jesus Christ**. Grow deeper in your faith by learning about why Christ died and how we are saved by the cross.

Topic: What does the Bible say about the LGBTQ issues that are so prevalent in the world today? Every Christian needs to know clearly and confidently what Scripture teaches as well as how to winsomely and effectively minister to those who struggle with these issues. 
